# WANTED: YOUR SECOND PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH WEDDING PHOTOS

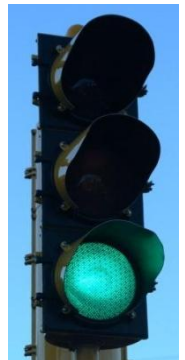

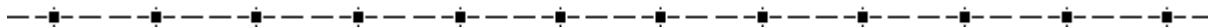

### YOUTH HAYRIDE

Directions to Jo and Danny Fields' home, 30 Briar Rose Lane, Waynesboro:

1. Take Route 250 (Richmond Road) towards Waynesboro.
2. At the traffic light for Old White Bridge Road, turn left.
3. Follow Old White Bridge Road all the way to Rte. 254 (Hermitage Road)
4. Turn right onto 254
5. At Hermitage village, "Hermitage Road" angles off to the left and then rejoins 254. When the roads join up again, start watching for Briar Rose Lane, on the left.
6. Turn left onto Briar Rose Lane, then left again at the first opportunity, into the Fields' driveway. If you pass a small lake beside 254 on the left, you have passed Briar Rose Lane!
