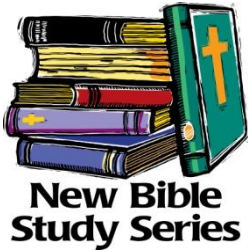

Also, I would like to thank all those who have so generously donated books. Please see me if you have any questions, suggestions, etc. regarding our new library.

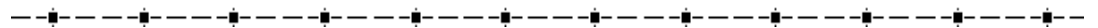

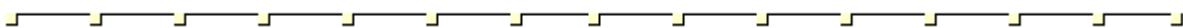
