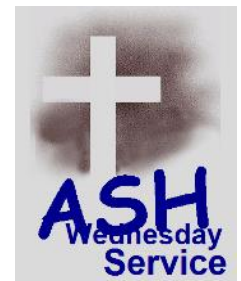
ANNOUNCEMENTS

How Can We Help?

Presbyterian Disaster Assistance, working with Church World Service, is currently sending shipments of Hygiene Kits to Haiti. These kits provide individuals with basic necessities. Since the Haiti shipments will deplete PDA's current stock of Hygiene Kits, they are in need of additional kits so that they will be ready for immediate shipment when the next disaster strikes.

Here at Second Church, Presbyterian Women will be collecting *Gift of the Heart* Hygiene Kits to help fill this need through February 14th. Anyone who wishes to participate should bring their assembled kits to the church and place them in the box marked "Hygiene Kits" that will be placed in the vestibule.

Each *Gift of the Heart* Hygiene Kit should include the following items, sealed in a one-gallon plastic bag with a zipper closure:

- 1 – hand towel (approximately 16"x28"; no fingertip or bath towels)
- 1 – washcloth
- 1 – wide-tooth comb
- 1 – nail clipper (no metal files or emery boards)
- 1 – bar of soap (bath size in wrapper)
- 1 – toothbrush (in original packaging); do not add toothpaste
- 6 – Band-Aids or other adhesive bandage strips

Thanks for your help with this project. It's one small way that we can assist those in need.
