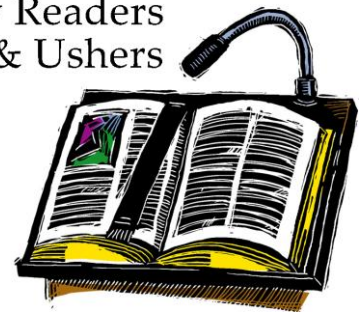

This is your last chance to stop by the Display Cabinet in the Fellowship Hall to see Lois Sensabaugh's collection of "patriotic memorabilia".

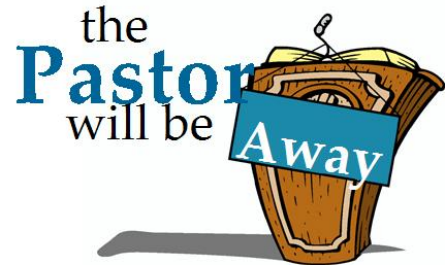
