**2. Olivet moderator.** Olivet is hearing the second of two candidates for the interim minister position on Sunday, February 23. They intend to make a choice at a special Session meeting on Sunday, February 27. They hope to have the person in the position by Easter Sunday (April 24). It is likely that my service as Olivet's moderator will end after the next presbytery meeting (May 10).

**6. New copier.** The new copier for the Church Office has been procured and has been in use for the past couple Sunday bulletins. The quality of the print is much darker and better. So far, we have only had one paper jam, using the large paper for large print bulletins, which was much simpler to clear than the old copier.

**7. Monthly tax deposits.** A new IRS procedure became effective this past month for making monthly deposits of tax withholdings. Previously, we made these deposits by check through Stellar One Bank. Now they must be made electronically over the IRS' EFTPS internet system. Everything is set up to do this, and the payment comes directly out of our checking account. This is a change in the church's fiscal procedure, as prior to this everything was paid or reimbursed by check, requiring the signature of one of our designated treasurers.

**8. Amendments voting.** As of February 22, here are the votes on the three major issues being voted on by the presbyteries:

- New Form of Government. . . . . 33 yes. . . . . 14 no. . . . . 87 needed to pass. . . . . 126 to vote
- Belhar Confession. . . . . 28 yes. . . . . 13 no. . . . . 116 needed to pass. . . . . 132 to vote
- Amendment 10-A (ordination). . . . . 31 yes. . . . . 26 no. . . . . 87 needed to pass. . . . . 116 to vote
