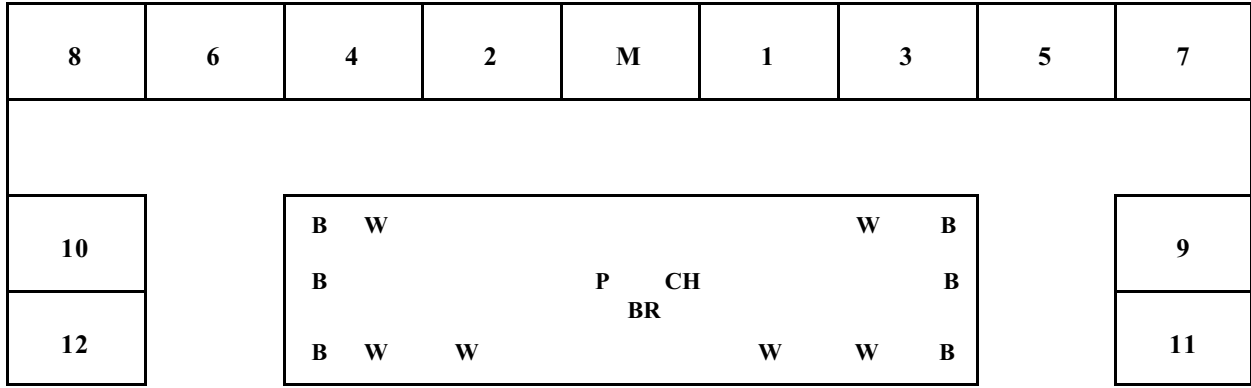

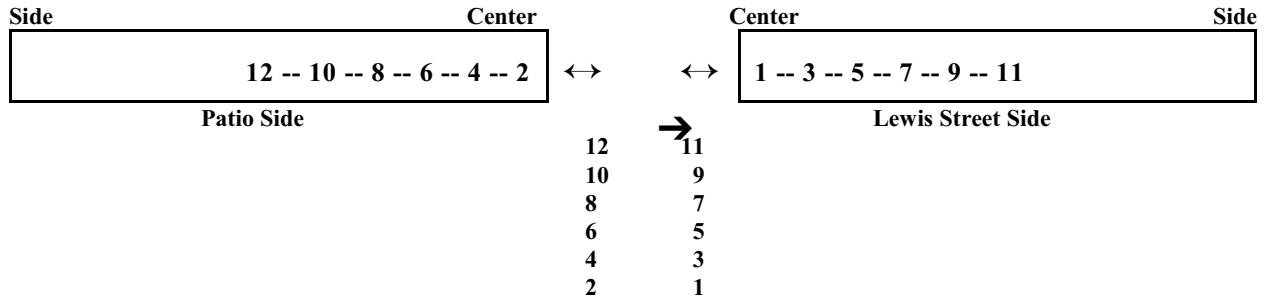
# COMMUNION SERVERS DIAGRAM

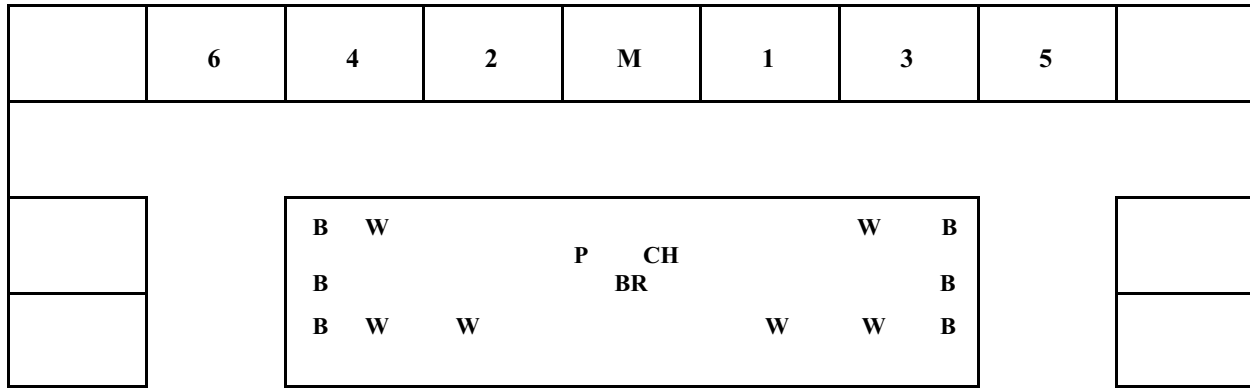


## PROCEDURE

2. **Bread.** Bread is served by Elders 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12
  - Elder 7 serves the pastor, then the choir, then the nursery
  - Elder 8 serves the organist, then the choir, then serves the balcony.
  - Elder 9 serves Lewis Street side of Sanctuary, center aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  - Elder 10 serves Patio side of Sanctuary, center aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  - Elder 11 serves Lewis Street side of Sanctuary, side aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  - Elder 12 serves Patio side of Sanctuary, side aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  
3. **Cup.** Wine is served by Elders 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6.
  - Elder 1 serves the pastor, then the choir, and then the balcony.
  - Elder 2 serves the organist, then the choir, then the nursery.
  - Elder 3 serves Lewis Street side of Sanctuary, center aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  - Elder 4 serves Patio side of Sanctuary, center aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  - Elder 5 serves Lewis Street side of Sanctuary, side aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  - Elder 6 serves Patio side of Sanctuary, side aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  
4. **Finish.** Elders 1-12 assemble in the rear of the Sanctuary, and proceed forward as a group. As soon as you are assembled, please come forward. Place the elements back on the table according to the diagram, above.

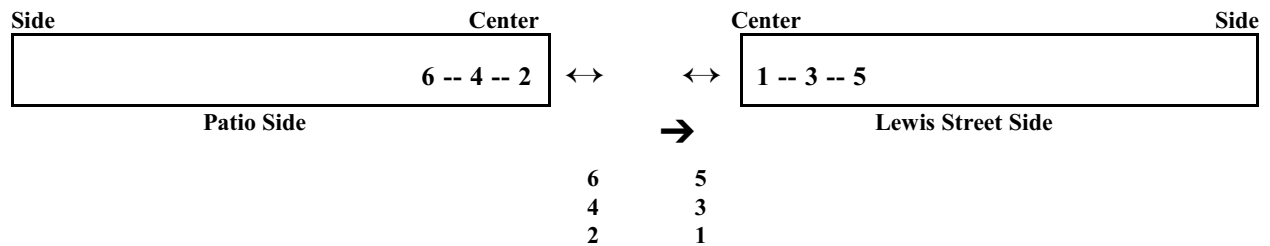
## COMMUNION SERVERS DIAGRAM – MAUNDY THURSDAY

### PROCEDURE

2. **Bread.** Bread is served by Elders 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6.
  - Elder 1 serves the pastor, then the choir, and then the balcony.
  - Elder 2 serves the organist, then the choir, then the nursery.
  - Elder 3 serves Lewis Street side of Sanctuary, center aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  - Elder 4 serves Patio side of Sanctuary, center aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  - Elder 5 serves Lewis Street side of Sanctuary, side aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  - Elder 6 serves Patio side of Sanctuary, side aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  
3. **Return.** Elders 1-6 assemble in the rear of the Sanctuary, and proceed forward as a group. Place the bread trays back on the table according to the diagram, above, and pick up wine for serving.
  
4. **Cup.** Wine is served by Elders 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6.
  - Elder 1 serves the pastor, then the choir, and then the balcony.
  - Elder 2 serves the organist, then the choir, then the nursery.
  - Elder 3 serves Lewis Street side of Sanctuary, center aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  - Elder 4 serves Patio side of Sanctuary, center aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  - Elder 5 serves Lewis Street side of Sanctuary, side aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  - Elder 6 serves Patio side of Sanctuary, side aisle, row-by-row to the back.
  
5. **Finish.** Elders 1-6 assemble in the rear of the Sanctuary, and proceed forward as a group. Place the elements back on the table according to the diagram, above, and be seated.
