

WORSHIP AND MUSIC COMMITTEE

The Worship and Music Committee is a Session Committee whose responsibilities are to help enrich the worship services of Second Presbyterian Church. To carry out these responsibilities, the committee met 9 times in 2008, usually before the regular monthly Session Meetings.

In order to achieve the goals of the committee, we schedule greeters, ushers, and lay readers for worship services. Also, we secure guest ministers and organists when needed. The planning for communion services and other special services falls in the duties of this committee.

Working with the Pastor, Organist and Choir Director, the committee helps plan and implement the music program. Allen Archer remains as Interim Organist while Pam Snyder directs the Adult Choir, Children's Choir and Handbell Choir.

During the year, the committee sponsored an Ash Wednesday Church night, Maundy Thursday Communion Service, Good Friday Service, Thanksgiving Service, Hanging of the Greens and Christmas Eve Candlelight Communion. They also honored mothers on Mother's Day and fathers on Father's Day. Along with the Christian Education Committee, the Worship and Music Committee honored the members of the Choirs and the Sunday School Teachers.
